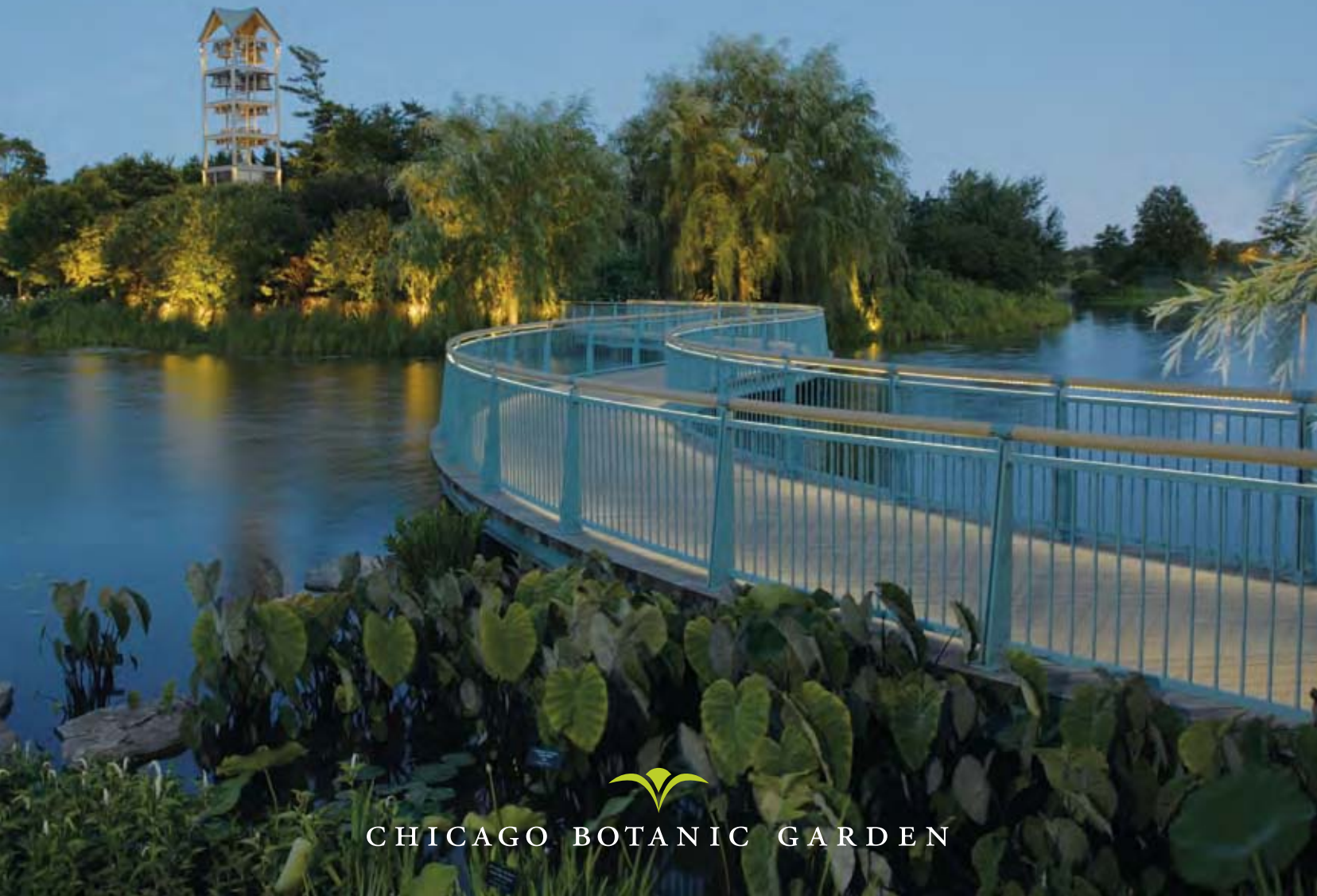




## EXCEPTIONAL CORPORATE EVENTS

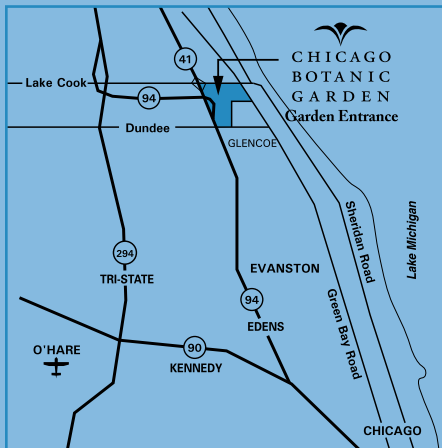

### EASY TO GET TO ON CHICAGO'S NORTH SHORE

The Garden's 385 acres are easily accessible, just 20 minutes north of downtown Chicago off the Edens Expressway (I-94) and U.S. Route 41, at the Lake Cook Road exit in Glencoe. Complimentary parking is available for your guests.

Metra's Union Pacific North Line station at Glencoe is minutes from the Garden. Rent the Chicago Botanic Garden trolley and your guests may be shuttled to and from area hotels or the Metra station.
