**Course:** Painting the Flowers of Summer, Watercolor on Vellum

**Required Materials:**

- Your own set of watercolors
- Sheet of drawing paper
- 2 Lead Holders:  
one with H lead  
one with 4H (the kind you sharpen in a pencil pointer)
- Magic Rub eraser, one of those white eraser holders that look like a pencil is useful (i.e. Eraser Stick)
- Excellent quality Kolinsky sable brushes – i.e. Winsor and Newton Series 7, Raphael 8404, Kalish Series 1 (less expensive) at [www.kalishfinestbrushes.biz](http://www.kalishfinestbrushes.biz)  
#2, #0, #00
- Water tub

**Below is the instructor's palette, you need not purchase these paints:**

Cadmium lemon	Cadmium green pale (Holbein)
Cadmium yellow, medium	Viridian green or Pthalo green
Cadmium orange	Chromium oxide
Cadmium red	Cobalt blue
Permanent magenta (quinacridone)	Mineral or ultramarine violet
Permanent rose (quinacridone)	Quinacridone gold
Burnt sienna
