



June - October The Event

The Garden Chef Series engages visitors in lively demonstrations on how to use seasonal, garden-fresh produce in creative ways. From June to October, on the second and fourth Saturday of each month, the series educates and entertains 300 visitors through two demonstration sessions per day. The series includes the Chicago Botanic Garden's own Windy City Harvest urban agriculture programs—VeggieRx and Youth Farm—on the second Saturday of each month. All recipes highlight fresh produce from the Regenstein Fruit & Vegetable Garden or the Windy City Harvest farm sites. On the fourth Saturday of each month, Chicago's top chefs share their culinary expertise, preparing a signature dish with fresh ingredients.



The Setting

Over the course of ten Saturdays, more than 3,000 visitors enjoy watching chefs work their magic in the kitchen of the Regenstein Fruit & Vegetable Garden's open-air amphitheater. Filled with more than 400 varieties of edible plants, vegetables, herbs, fruits, and nuts, the Fruit & Vegetable Garden is a perfect setting for this interactive and fun outdoor event. The demonstrations are free with paid Garden admission and take place on two Saturdays each month. Two demonstration sessions are held each day of the series, at 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m.
