The Experience

Night of 1,000 Jack-o'-Lanterns brings unique Halloween fun to the Chicago Botanic Garden. More than 1,000 hand-carved jack-o'-lanterns—75 of them weighing more than 150 pounds—light up the Garden for fifteen nights during this fantastic, all-ages, nighttime event. The large, elaborately carved pumpkins are created by professional artists and arranged as illuminated displays. Featured pumpkins include images of superheroes, celebrities, and Chicago-inspired themes.



The Setting

Night of 1,000 Jack-o'-Lanterns provides a rare opportunity to experience the Garden after hours. All pumpkins are lit with LED lights and placed along a paved walking trail, where visitors enjoy an evening stroll that winds throughout the Garden. Seasonal fare and beverages—such as apple cider donuts, hot cider, and ales—are available for purchase. The evening takes on a festive air, with live pumpkin carvers and costumed entertainers along the path at this family-friendly event.

The Visitors

More than 60,000 visitors come to experience Night of 1,000 Jack-o'-Lanterns during its run, including an attractive demographic mix of the Garden's individual and family members, and an entirely new audience of guests from the greater Chicago area and beyond. The audience includes people of all ages, including families with children and millennials, who come to celebrate the fall season.
